



■ BeBoldBlueprint™ First 10 Days – Student Survey Guide

Purpose

This quick check-in captures how students are feeling after the BeBoldBlueprint™ First 10 Days. It helps measure belonging, engagement, and readiness.

Survey Setup Instructions

1. Platform: Create a Google Form or use another survey platform your school prefers.
2. Delivery: Share the link/QR code with students during advisory on Day 10.
3. Timing: Allow 5–7 minutes at the end of the session for completion.
4. Confidentiality: Remind students their responses are anonymous and valued.

Survey Questions (Copy & Paste)

1. After the First 10 Days, do you feel more connected to your school community? (Yes / Somewhat / No)
2. Which prompt made you think the most? (Open response)
3. What's one change you'd like to see at our school to help students feel more supported? (Open response)
4. Do you believe your school is preparing you for life after graduation? (Yes / Somewhat / No)
5. One word to describe how you feel about this school year so far: (Open response)

Suggested Wrap-Up Language (for teachers to read aloud)

"Thank you for sharing your voice. Every answer helps us make our school stronger and more supportive."

Next Steps for Leaders

- Review responses for themes in belonging, readiness, and equity gaps.
- Use the Admin Debrief Tool alongside survey data to identify patterns.
- Share high-level takeaways with staff to keep momentum going.

This starter survey is just the beginning. Partner schools receive:

- Expanded student voice survey templates
- Disaggregated data dashboards (by subgroup, first-gen status, IEP/504, etc.)

- A full Equity Debrief Protocol for leadership teams
